Staff Qualifications Generic Statement

To Whom it may concern

Climbing:

Person leading the tower will hold the Scout Association Adventurous Activity Climbing Permit or SPA or CWA award. Belayers will hold same or equivalent qualifications and/or deemed competent and supervised by the Tower Leader.

Archery:

Instructor will hold the Scout Association Adventurous Activity Climbing Permit or the Archery GB Instructor Award.

Air Rifles:

Instructor will hold the National Small-bore Rifle Association (NSRA) Youth Proficiency Scheme Tutor Award or a higher NSRA qualification.

Other Activities:

All other activities do not need specific training qualifications but will be led by instructors who have had prior experience and/or in-house training.

All staff aged 18 & over will be DBS cleared via the Scout Association.

All staff aged 18 & over will have undertaken Scout First Response First Aid Training & the full-time staff & Centre Manager hold First Aid at Work qualifications.
